IAP Academic Notes

Courses: After completing two language courses during the summer SASLI program, students will take two 4- credit language courses while abroad on the American Councils SAFLI program. For the fall semester, students will take the next two courses in the language sequence. Students will also receive a 4 credit readings course on your transcript. This amounts to 12 credits in total for the fall semester. See below for the UW-Madison language sequence:

Your fall semester courses will be sent to IAP on an American Councils transcript. IAP will process these courses to a UW-Madison transcript with credit, grades and the course equivalents as listed above. Both the summer and fall credits will be on the same transcript.
