

Hindi & Urdu SAFLI (Summer 2022)

Academic Notes

The Academic Program: Upon arrival to the South Asia Summer Language Institute (SASLI) program, you will be placed in the appropriate language level of Hindi or Urdu for the summer term. The program is hosted at the University of Wisconsin - Madison.

Courses: Students will take two courses in the language sequence, each 4-credits, while in UW-Madison's SASLI program. Students will receive 8 credits in total for the summer program. See below for the UW-Madison language sequence:

Levels	Hindi/Urdu Course Equivalency
First Semester	ASIALANG 317
Second Semester	ASIALANG 327
Third Semester	ASIALANG 417
Fourth Semester	ASIALANG 427
Fifth Semester	ASIALANG 517
Sixth Semester	ASIALANG 527

Note: These are all topics courses, ex. ASIALANG 317 = First Semester South Asian Language (topic: First Semester Hindi or First Semester Urdu).

Additionally: Summer course numbers will show as higher-level courses (ex. 300 level course) than those during the fall semester abroad (ex. 200 level course) in your final transcripts. Because courses during the summer are administered and structured differently, a student who may take First and Second Semester Hindi or Urdu during the summer would receive credit for ASIALANG 317 & 327, while during the fall they would receive 200-level credits for Third and Fourth Semester Hindi or Urdu. This varying course number system applies to all levels of Hindi and Urdu. Please refer to the study abroad academic notes for more details.
